<p><i>Identify <u>at least three predictions</u> from your search engine results; these predictions should be based on reading the <u>URL and search engine descriptions</u>. Your predictions should help the group <u>anticipate what information will be found at the website location</u>.</i></p>	<p><i>Pose <u>at least three questions about the information you have located</u>. These can be <u>thought questions</u> that make you want to know more about <u>your topic or another topic</u>.</i></p>	<p><i>Identify <u>at least three pieces of information that raise questions for you</u>. These could include questions that <u>address confusing information, conflicting information, or the website's source or author</u>.</i></p>	<p><i>Beyond restating the information located across websites, identify what you think are the <u>three most important details</u> that answer your information problem and <u>explain why they are important and how they are connected</u>.</i></p>	<p><i>Make <u>at least three connections</u> between the information in your reading to <u>your own experience, the world around you, or other sources of information</u>. Be prepared to explain these connections to your group.</i></p>
